Chapter 3 Bible Study Message & Concepts

Scripture Highlight:

1 Corinthians 6:2 (KJV) Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world?..

Message Highlight: It is important to understand that the second coming and the final judgment are not the same event in time. The reward of everlasting life will not be awarded until the final judgment is complete.

Revelation 11:18 (KJV) And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldst give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldst destroy them which destroy the earth.

Thought to Ponder: If the decision is made concerning who is saved and who is lost, during the second coming... what need is there for a final judgment?
