Chapter 5 Bible Study Message & Concepts

Scripture Highlight:

Matthew 24:34 (KJV) Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled.

Message Highlight: In Matthew 24 Jesus specifically laid out the signs that His disciples were to look out for, before His return for them. Throughout their writings, the apostles documented the fulfillment of those signs.

Revelation 19:10 ...for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.

Thought to Ponder: Some Christians have been taught that one day, without notice, all believers could vanish from off the face of the earth, while many others are waiting for Christ to return in the clouds to take them far away. If this was the case, why would Jesus tell His disciples that He would return in their own generation? Since we were not around to see what occurred in those days long ago, Jesus' testimony needs to trump all other testimonies concerning the end times.

Concept Highlight: Throughout His ministry on earth, Jesus taught and warned the people of Israel concerning “the *day* of the Lord”, that was coming upon them in their future (Matthew 23:36). When reading Jesus' testimony in Matthew 24, and the writings from Daniel and Revelation, it's quite clear that the “terrible *day*” was going to be accompanied by something monumental; that being His second coming.

Daniel's Vision: Daniel 7:17-18, Daniel 7:21-22, Daniel 12:1-3

Jesus' Testimony: Matthew 13:47-50 Matthew 24:34-41

Revelation: Rev 6:16-17; Rev 7:1-3, Rev 14:1, Rev 20:1-8

Supporting Notes: While Jesus was hanging on the cross, He promise the thief that hung beside Him, that he would be with Him in paradise; in that same *day* (Luke 23:39-43). Jesus did not tell the thief that generations would pass then eventually he would be in paradise; instead he said he would enter the kingdom of heaven in that same generation (*day*). This is due to the fact that the kingdom of heaven was truly at hand for the old covenant abiding Jews, and for those who were elected by grace (Romans 11:5). It's clear that by accepting Christ that day, the thief obtained his place in heaven at the 1st resurrection that was soon to come.
