Chapter 6 Bible Study Message & Concepts

Scripture Highlight: *Revelation 7:4 (KJV) And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.*

Message Highlight: There are two groups of people who will be found worthy to inherit the world made new, and will have a place in New Jerusalem. These two groups are the 144,000 saints and the multitude of believers from all the nations of the earth.

Revelation 7:9 After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands.

Thought to Ponder: If all believers are counted to be one of the saints, why would the bible designate a number and assign it to the tribes of Israel (Rev 7:4)? Wouldn't it have been written that the number of saints who were sealed come from all the nations of the earth; if it were so?

Concept Highlight: When you read the end time prophecies, you can decipher which ones were relevant for the 1st century and which ones are important for later generations. The saints are now dwelling in heaven until Christ returns with the kingdom, so many of the prophecies have passed, while others will soon be fulfilled. After studying the prophecies, you will be able to pick out where they belong in the timeline.
